Buffalo Grove Park District Board Appointment

(Buffalo Grove Park District, Buffalo Grove, IL) - The Buffalo Grove Park District Board of Commissioners is excited to announce that Kim Page has been selected to fill the previously vacant Board seat. Page was sworn in on Monday, November 13 and will fill the remainder of the term until April 2025.

Page has bachelor's degree in public health from Northern Illinois University and works for Digital Currency Systems in Northbrook. Both she and her husband Scott grew up in Buffalo Grove and are raising their three children here too.

Page's community volunteer experience includes the Anti-Cruelty Society, Omni Youth Services, GiveNKind, Boy Scouts of America, and the Aptakisic-Tripp School District 102 PTO.

Page said, "I am honored and excited to have this opportunity to serve our Park District and community. With three children ages 8, 9, and 11, I have been a long-time fan of the Buffalo Grove Park District and their programs, which I have made extensive use of. I am looking forward to serving the community through making our Park District the best possible."
