# WELCOME!

It's never too early to start planning for summer camp! The Buffalo Grove Park District has a variety of summer camp offerings that are sure to make your child's experience a great one.



## Camp Staff

The Buffalo Grove Park District's summer camp staff will provide the best summer possible for your child. We hire our staff based on their character, leadership, enthusiasm, and creativity.

All Buffalo Grove Park District summer camps have an on-site supervisor to encourage leadership and guidance for each of our unique camps. Many of the previous summer camp supervisors will also be back, full of fresh ideas and renewed commitment. All summer camp staff complete a thorough orientation process that incorporates safety, creativity, team building, and daily activity planning. All camp supervisors are certified in National Safety Council first aid, CPR, and AED.

## Camp Site Locations

In addition to using some of our own facilities, through cooperative arrangements with School Districts 21, 96, and 102, we strive to provide the best facilities for our summer day camps. Due to capital improvement projects at the various school districts, all camp locations are subject to change.

## Transportation

The Buffalo Grove Park District does not provide daily transportation to or from camp, however we do utilize a school bus service for swimming and our many fun field trips.

## Registration Information

The registration deadline is 1 week prior to the first day of each session for all camps, as well as Post Summer Camp field trips. All registrations received after those dates will need supervisor approval if spaces are available.

## Establishing Residency & Household Account

Newly created accounts are flagged as out-of-district until proof of in-district residency is established. Visit our website at [bgparks.org](http://bgparks.org) and click on "Program Registration" at the bottom of the page to begin the process of creating your account.

You must provide proof of residency at the Alcott Center to receive in-district registration access. The only acceptable forms of proof include a valid driver's license or state identification card, or a current electric, gas, water or garbage bill. ## Online Registration Process

In order to register online you must have your household account set up in the Park District's registration system. If you have an account, please verify your username and password prior to the first day of registration. If you do not remember your information there is a link on the login page for username and password retrieval. In-person registration is accepted at the Alcott Center.

## Payment Options

<b>1</b>	<b>Option # 1 - Full Payment</b> Full payment: Full payment includes the \$100 nonrefundable deposit per session per camper at time of registration.	
<b>2</b>	<b>Option # 2 - Auto-Debit Installment Plan</b> This includes the \$100 nonrefundable deposit per session per camper at time of registration. The balance is auto-debited into 3 equal payments on March 3, April 1, and May 1.	
<b>1st payment</b> March 3	<b>2nd payment</b> April 1	<b>Final Payment</b> May 1

## Payment Methods

We accept cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover. If you have any questions, call the registration office at 847.850.2101.

## Refunds

Refund requests received on or before 1 week prior to the first day of camp session will be issued, minus the nonrefundable \$100 deposit and a \$5 administrative fee. Refund requests received after those dates will only be issued when accompanied by a current doctor's note. Refund requests for Post Summer Adventure received on or before 1 week prior to the first day will receive a full refund, minus a \$5 administrative fee. Refund requests after that day will receive a 50% refund.

## Waitlist

Campers can be on no more than 2 waitlists per session. Each child can be enrolled in one camp and one waitlist per session, or they can be on 2 waitlists and not be currently enrolled in a camp.

## Transfers

Families may transfer from camps and waitlists only once. Additional transfer requests will be charged \$15. Visit the camps page of our website for the Refund/Transfer Request form.

The Buffalo Grove Park District reserves the right to cancel any camp with insufficient enrollment. If a camp is canceled by the Park District, all registered campers in that program will be contacted and offered an alternate camp. A full refund will be given to each participant the Park District is unable to accommodate.

# CAMP CONNECTION

Camp Connection is a before- and after-camp program designed to accommodate working parents. Camp Connection will be managed like camp and will not just be free play. Activities will include sports, arts and crafts, indoor and outdoor games, and other fun summertime activities.

Camp Connection is only for campers who are enrolled in the Buffalo Grove Park District Camp programs and must be entering Kindergarten through 8th grade next fall.

The morning Camp Connection begins as early as 7 am and ends at the starting time of the camper's individual camp. The afternoon Camp Connection will start when the camper's individual camp ends and goes until 6 pm. Snack will be provided in the afternoon session only during Camp Connection. Any children with food allergies may bring their own snack each day.

The Park District will do everything possible to keep Camp Connection locations at each camp site. However, due to varying levels of enrollment, participants may have to be transported to another location. In these instances, transportation from the participant's camp site to the Camp Connection location will be provided.

Camp Connection is a separate registration from camp. When you complete your camp registration, please indicate your interest in Camp Connection in the questions. Camp Connection registration information will be sent to those who indicated interest, as well as updated on the website. Camp Connection registration will open March 3 and close May 30. All registrations received after May 30 will be placed on a waitlist and contacted once a spot opens. **Please note:** There is a 2-day minimum per week.
